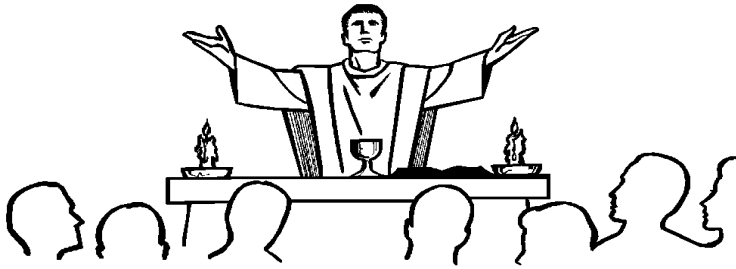

LIHEAP Assistance Still Available

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has emergency assistance available to current LIHEAP recipients that are still having difficulty paying their winter heating bills.

If you have a shut-off or special notice on your PSE&G electric or natural gas heating bill, you may be eligible to receive additional monies toward your heating bill. This money can help you to pay off your overdue bill.
