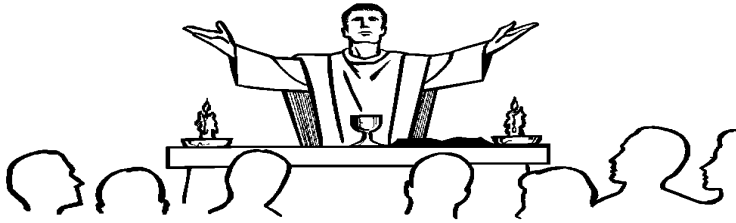

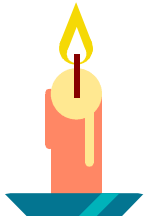

Stewardship Sharing

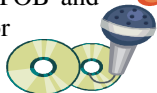
"Carry no money bag, no sack, no sandals..." (Luke 10:4a)
