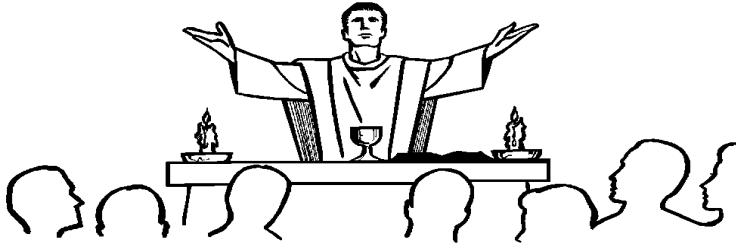

They shouted aloud, 'Victory to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!' " (Revelation 7:9-10)

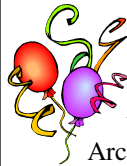
